CONVERSATION

THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE

Today your child learned that God helps people do what is right. Daniel knew it was against the king's law to pray to God, but he obeyed God, not the king.



LIVE IT OUT

Daniel

BASED ON DANIEL 6:1-23

WEEKLY VERSE: God helps me. I will not be afraid. *Hebrews 13:6*

LIFE POINT: God helps people do what is right.



Daniel prayed only to God.

The king made a new law that people could only pray to him.

Daniel still prayed to God.

The king put Daniel in with lions.

God took care of Daniel and kept him safe.



Daniel loved, obeyed, and prayed to God each day.

Daniel was a leader over many people. Some of the people were mean.

The mean people told the king that Daniel prayed to God and not to the king.

The king put Daniel in with some lions!

God closed the lions' mouths. God loved Daniel and kept him safe.



Daniel loved and obeyed God. He was a leader over many people. Some people looked for ways to get Daniel in trouble with the king.


These mean people got the king to sign a new law that said everyone had to pray to the king and no one else.

Daniel heard about the law. He chose to obey God and pray to Him.

The king called out to Daniel the next day. Daniel told him God had closed the lion's mouths. God kept Daniel safe.

PRETEND to be a Lion

Show your child a picture of a lion. Ask her to name the animal. Suggest your child pretend to be a lion. Spread a blanket over some chairs to make a lions' den.
Sit in the den with your child and talk about the Bible story (reverse side).

PRAY Together

Lead a family prayer time. Mention that Daniel prayed to God. Say the Weekly Verse: "God helps me. I will not be afraid. Hebrews 13:6."

Search for HEARTS

Cut three hearts from paper. Tape the hearts around the house at eye level for your child. Challenge your child to find a heart. Point to the first found heart and say: "God loves people." Lead him to pray a simple prayer. Repeat with the other two hearts. Invite your child to look at the Bible story picture (reverse side) as you tell the Bible story.
